OLD TESTAMENT READING (Continued)

³ For the lips of a loose woman drip honey, and her speech is smoother than oil; ⁴ but in the end she is bitter as wormwood, sharp as a two-edged sword. ⁵ Her feet go down to death; her steps follow the path to Sheol. ⁶ She does not keep straight to the path of life; her ways wander, and she does not know it. ⁷ And now, my child,^[b] listen to me, and do not depart from the words of my mouth. ⁸Keep vour wav far from her. and do not go near the door of her house; ⁹ or you will give your honor to others, and your years to the merciless, ¹⁰ and strangers will take their fill of your wealth, and your labors will go to the house of an alien; ¹¹ and at the end of your life you will groan, when your flesh and body are consumed, ¹² and you say, "Oh, how I hated discipline, and my heart despised reproof! ¹³ I did not listen to the voice of my teachers or incline my ear to my instructors. ¹⁴ Now I am at the point of utter ruin in the public assembly."

NEW TESTAMENT READING

¹² Indeed, the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing until it divides soul from spirit, joints from marrow; it is able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart. ¹³ And before him no creature is hidden, but all are naked and laid bare to the eyes of the one to whom we must render an account.

¹⁴ Since, then, we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast to our confession. ¹⁵ For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin. ¹⁶ Let us therefore approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
