OLD TESTAMENT READING

Proverbs 13:1-13


- ¹ A wise child loves discipline, but a scoffer does not listen to rebuke.
- ² From the fruit of their words good persons eat good things, but the desire of the treacherous is for wrongdoing.
- ³ Those who guard their mouths preserve their lives; those who open wide their lips come to ruin.
- ⁴ The appetite of the lazy craves, and gets nothing, while the appetite of the diligent is richly supplied.
- ⁵ The righteous hate falsehood, but the wicked act shamefully and disgracefully.
- ⁶ Righteousness guards one whose way is upright, but sin overthrows the wicked.
- ⁷ Some pretend to be rich, yet have nothing; others pretend to be poor, yet have great wealth.

OLD TESTAMENT READING (Continued)

- ⁸ Wealth is a ransom for a person's life, but the poor get no threats.
- ⁹ The light of the righteous rejoices, but the lamp of the wicked goes out.
- ¹⁰ By insolence the heedless make strife, but wisdom is with those who take advice.
- Wealth hastily gotten will dwindle, but those who gather little by little will increase it.
- ¹² Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but a desire fulfilled is a tree of life.
- 13 Those who despise the word bring destruction on themselves, but those who respect the commandment will be rewarded.

¹ If I speak in the tongues of mortals and of angels, but do not have love, I am a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. ² And if I have prophetic powers, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. ³ If I give away all my possessions, and if I hand over my body so that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing.

⁴Love is patient; love is kind; love is not envious or boastful or arrogant ⁵ or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; ⁶ it does not rejoice in wrongdoing, but rejoices in the truth. ⁷ It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

⁸Love never ends. But as for prophecies, they will come to an end; as for tongues, they will cease; as for knowledge, it will come to an end. ⁹ For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part; ¹⁰ but when the complete comes, the partial will come to an end. ¹¹ When I was a child, I spoke like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child; when I became an adult, I put an end to childish ways. ¹² For now we see in a mirror, dimly, ^[b] but then we will see face to face. Now I know only in part; then I will know fully, even as I have been fully known. ¹³ And now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; and the greatest of these is love.
