OLD TESTAMENT READING

Proverbs 30:11-23

¹¹ There are those who curse their fathers and do not bless their mothers. ¹² There are those who are pure in their own eyes, yet are not cleansed of their filthiness. ¹³ There are those—how lofty are their eyes, how high their eyelids lift!-¹⁴ there are those whose teeth are swords, whose teeth are knives to devour the poor from off the earth, the needy from among mortals. ¹⁵ The leech has two daughters; "Give, give," they cry. Three things are never satisfied; four never say, "Enough": ¹⁶ Sheol, the barren womb, the earth ever-thirsty for water, and the fire that never says, "Enough." ¹⁷ The eye that mocks a father and scorns to obey a mother will be pecked out by the ravens of the valley and eaten by the vultures. ¹⁸ Three things are too wonderful for me; four I do not understand: ¹⁹ the way of an eagle in the sky, the way of a snake on a rock, the way of a ship on the high seas, and the way of a man with a woman. ²⁰ This is the way of an adulteress: she eats and wipes her mouth and says, "I have done no wrong." ²¹ Under three things the earth trembles; under four it cannot bear up: ²² a slave when he becomes king and a fool when glutted with food, ²³ a contemptible woman when she gets a husband and a maid when she supplants her mistress.

Luke 18:1-8

¹ Then Jesus told them a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart. ² He said, "In a certain city there was a judge who neither feared God nor had respect for people. ³ In that city there was a widow who kept coming to him and saying, 'Grant me justice against my accuser.' ⁴ For a while he refused, but later he said to himself, 'Though I have no fear of God and no respect for anyone, ⁵ yet because this widow keeps bothering me, I will grant her justice, so that she may not wear me out by continually coming.' " ⁶ And the Lord said, "Listen to what the unjust judge says. ⁷ And will not God grant justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long in helping them? ⁸ I tell you, he will quickly grant justice to them. And yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"
