# OLD TESTAMENT READING

<sup>24</sup> Four things on earth are small, yet they are exceedingly wise: <sup>25</sup> the ants are a people without strength, yet they provide their food in the summer; <sup>26</sup> the badgers are a people without power, yet they make their homes in the rocks; <sup>27</sup> the locusts have no king, yet all of them march in rank; <sup>28</sup> the lizard can be grasped in the hand, yet it is found in kings' palaces. <sup>29</sup> Three things are stately in their stride; four are stately in their gait: <sup>30</sup> the lion, which is mightiest among wild animals and does not turn back before any; <sup>31</sup> the strutting rooster, the he-goat, and a king against whom none can stand. <sup>32</sup> If you have been foolish, exalting yourself, or if you have been devising evil, put your hand on your mouth. <sup>33</sup> For as pressing milk produces curds and pressing the nose produces blood, so pressing anger produces strife.

Luke 18:9-14

<sup>9</sup> He also told this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous and regarded others with contempt: <sup>10</sup> "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. <sup>11</sup> The Pharisee, standing by himself, was praying thus, 'God, I thank you that I am not like other people: thieves, rogues, adulterers, or even like this tax collector. <sup>12</sup> I fast twice a week; I give a tenth of all my income.' <sup>13</sup> But the tax collector, standing far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven but was beating his breast and saying, 'God, be merciful to me, a sinner!' <sup>14</sup> I tell you, this man went down to his home justified rather than the other, for all who exalt themselves will be humbled, but all who humble themselves will be exalted."


