<sup>25</sup> During Solomon's lifetime Judah and Israel lived in safety, from Dan even to Beer-sheba, all of them under their vines and fig trees. <sup>26</sup> Solomon also had forty thousand stalls of horses for his chariots and twelve thousand horsemen. <sup>27</sup> Those officials supplied provisions for King Solomon and for all who came to King Solomon's table, each one in his month; they let nothing be lacking. <sup>28</sup> They also brought to the required place barley and straw for the horses and swift steeds, each according to his charge.

### Fame of Solomon's Wisdom

<sup>29</sup> God gave Solomon very great wisdom, discernment, and breadth of understanding as vast as the sand on the seashore, <sup>30</sup> so that Solomon's wisdom surpassed the wisdom of all the people of the East and all the wisdom of Egypt. <sup>31</sup> He was wiser than anyone else, wiser than Ethan the Ezrahite and Heman, Calcol, and Darda, children of Mahol; his fame spread throughout all the surrounding nations. <sup>32</sup> He composed three thousand proverbs, and his songs numbered a thousand and five. <sup>33</sup> He would speak of trees, from the cedar that is in the Lebanon to the hyssop that grows in the wall; he would speak of animals, and birds, and reptiles, and fish. <sup>34</sup> People came from all the nations to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from all the kings of the earth who had heard of his wisdom.
